Overseas Students can only enrol at Diploma level and above, and MUST complete their Award in its minimum time. This usually requires 4 units per semester.

- The ACTUAL COST per Unit* includes the ACT Admin fee, shown separately in the next column in the table above.
- Morling College continues to subsidise the ACT scheduled rate by several hundred dollars per Unit*.
- Morling College students complete their ACT enrolment with their Morling enrolment.
- Fees are due at the end of Week 1 of any Semester.
- Full-time postgraduate research students are charged at 2 Units* per Semester; part-time at 1 Unit* per semester.
- Coursework post-graduate students are charged per Unit taken.
- All Language Units* are now charged the Degree-level rate for all Award levels.
- From 2008 new SEBL students were charged the tuition fee set for their Award level, divided into quarters across the four semesters of SEBL.

Full-Time Designation

Usually full-time students (on-campus, not Distance) are expected to do 4 Units per Semester and to be involved in the following extra-curricular activities:

A student may do 3 Units in a Semester and still be deemed full-time, but must still be involved in the above activities. A student may do 3 Units per semester and be deemed *part-time*, but must apply in writing for permission, offering justification for approval.

Full-Time Discount

All full-time undergraduate and postgraduate students are entitled to apply for any of the following:

- A full-time Fee discount of 5% on the total Morling fee (*i.e.*, the total fee less the ACT Admin Fee per Unit*)
- A Morling Scholarship Scheme Grant and/or a Baptist Foundation Scholarship (*see below*)
- A 'spouse' rebate (*see below*)
- An 'audit' of up to one subject per Semester at no cost (*see below*)

Pastoral Ministry Discount

Any part-time student who is engaged in full-time ministry in a NSW Baptist Union church may apply for either or both of the following:

- A full-time Fee subsidy of 5% on the total Morling fee
- A Morling Scholarship Scheme Grant

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Morling Scholarship Scheme provides financial assistance on application for capable full-time students in second year or above who are seeking to enter a ministry position at the conclusion of their studies.

➤ Morling Scholarships

These are available for full-time students (distance or on-campus) in second or subsequent years, *or* part-time students in full-time Baptist ministry. They consist of a reduction in fees. On-campus students need to have fulfilled all requirements of full-time students. These will be credited to successful applicants' accounts at the end of the semester.

➤ Baptist Foundation Scholarships

The Baptist Foundation generously supports students through a number of scholarships. These are available for full-time students (distance or on-campus) in second or subsequent years. These will be credited to successful applicants' accounts towards the end of the year.

'Spouse' rebate

Spouses of full-time students will be allowed to study one (non-Distance) Morling Unit at $\frac{1}{3}$ of the Morling College Tuition Fee per Semester. For additional Units they will be charged $\frac{1}{2}$ if they are not receiving Austudy, or $\frac{2}{3}$ if they are.

Spouses of full-time Accreditation candidates will study all Units free of charge from the start of the Semester following acceptance by the Committee for Ministry. These discounts do not apply to postgraduate or Counselling courses, or to students who use FEE-HELP.

Audit

Full-time, on-campus students may audit 1 Unit per Semester free. Others may audit at the "Audit" rate.
