# Keynote Speakers

## Steve Stroepe.

Lead Pastor of Lake Pointe Church and has been serving Lake Pointe Church for over 27 years with his wife Marsha. They have two daughters, Rachael and Lydia, and three grandchildren.



Steve was called as the first pastor of Lake Pointe Baptist Church in 1980, and received his Master of Divinity from Southwestern Seminary. Under his leadership, Lake Pointe has grown from an average attendance of 57 in 1980 to a current attendance of over 10,000 each weekend including children. The budget has grown from \$125,000 a year to over \$14 million a year.

Steve's spiritual gifts are evangelism, leadership, and teaching. He has a passion for seeing that the Gospel is presented to unchurched people in a culturally relevant style without compromising its truth. He also believes that one of the keys to an effective church is keeping a balance between evangelism and discipleship. Because of this belief, he has been a strong supporter of the small group ministry at Lake Pointe. Although he is a sought-after speaker and church consultant both nationally and throughout the world, his heart is for the local church, and he looks forward to many more years of ministry at Lake Pointe. Tim Keel is the author of *Intuitive Leadership* and the founding pastor of Jacob's Well Church in Kansas City, Missouri. He is married to Mimi and together they have three children: Mabry, Annie, and Blaise. Tim received a BFA in Design from the University of Kansas and a Masters of Divinity from Denver Seminary. Tim is an avid reader and loves to learn, write, and teach. He is passionate about creating spaces for people to connect to God, themselves and others.



Jacob's Well Church began with a handful of people in 1998. Their mission is to be an authentic, biblical community where people experience and express the reality of God's love in the way of Jesus. Their name reflects that dream and mission. In the New Testament book of John, Jesus encounters a woman who is at the fringes of her culture, a woman with great hunger and great need. He is currently the Senior Pastor at Camberwell Baptist and is occupied with how to transform a traditional church towards being missional.



He has degrees from Victoria University; Australia College of Theology- Bible College of Victoria; St Mark's National Theological Centre- Charles Sturt University and a Doctor of Ministry from Fuller Theological Centre in Pasadena, CA in Missional Leadership. He is also involved in ongoing research around mission in Western culture(s) through the Allelon Foundation. Andrew is married to Kim and they have two young children, a dog and a cat. His interests include slow food, good coffee, viticulture, friends, travel, sport, nature and being outdoors.
