Through the Morling Foundation, Faculty members of Morling College have been funded to complete further postgraduate theological education. One such person is Rev David Starling who is completing his PhD in New Testament Studies, investigating Paul's understanding of salvation and his way of reading the Old Testament.

Investing in our Baptist Youth (Gap Year)

In collaboration with BYM (Baptist Youth Ministries), Morling College is launching a leadership program for students between 18 and 21 years of age. The program runs on a Certificate IV level course augmented by a number of practical experiences where students are encouraged to grow deeper into their commitment to Jesus. The Foundation has committed seeding funding to this exciting program.



Taking the College Beyond its Walls (Regional College)



In 2006 Morling College commenced a satellite campus for the churches of the Australian Capital Territory through using our distance education program augmented by tutorials. In the first two years we had used a range of tutors. In 2008, with the help of Morling Foundation, a number of lectures are being planned.

Equipping our Pastors (Postgraduate Studies)



In fulfilling our goal to resource theological education, Morling Foundation is seeking to help the College fund a position for a Postgraduate Studies Coordinator. This role will principally be aimed to assist pastors in further theological education development through a range of masters and doctoral programs.

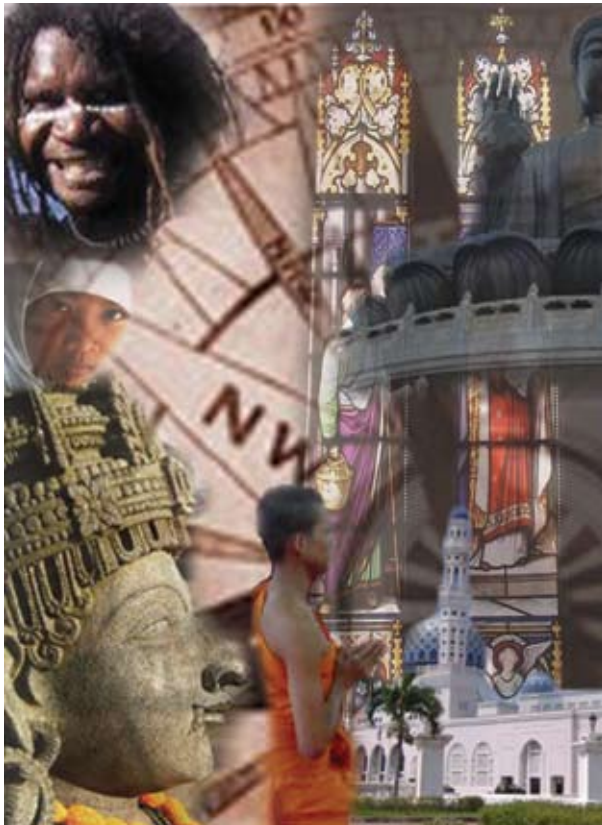
