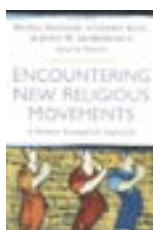
Making Disciples: The Significance of Jesus' Educational Methods for Today's Church

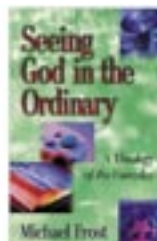
The Shaping of Things to Come

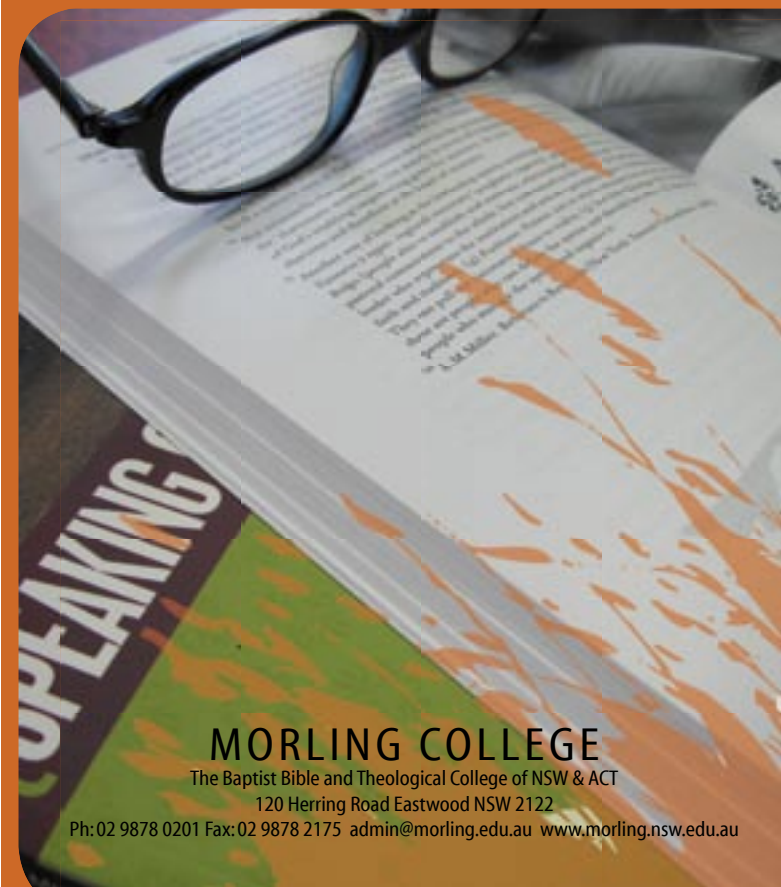
Religious and Non-religious Spirituality in the Western World, Lausanne Occasional Paper No.45

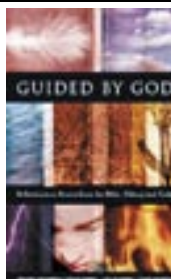
